THE SEASONAL WORKERS CHALLENGE FACING TASMANIA

The Tasmanian agricultural industry relies heavily on seasonal workers travelling from interstate and internationally to fill the labour requirements over the summer period. With the emergence of COVID-19, and the subsequent border restrictions enforced, this has meant that growers are facing significant labour shortages over the busiest period of their production systems.
