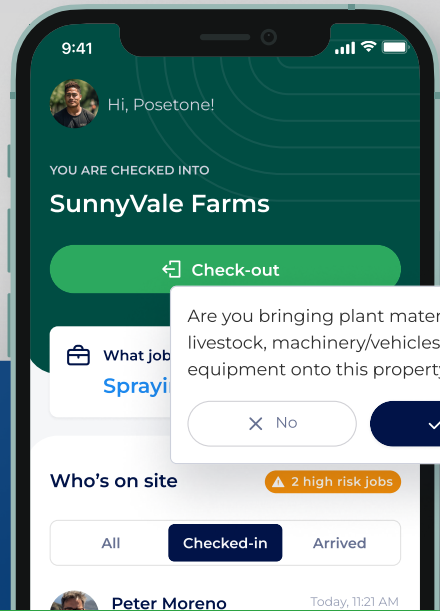

## Digitally map your farm

Create and share a live map of your property - an Onside product specialist will be onsite to help get you set up



## Automate visitor notifications

Growers receive live visitor notifications, no matter where they are, or how many entrances. Field staff can automatically let growers know that they've arrived



## Capture high risk biosecurity movements

Visitors can record plant material, machinery and equipment movements on and off your property



## Contribute to real-time tracing

Share an anonymised view of check-in movement data on and off farm with AUSVEG



## Access pest and disease updates

Pick up resources and free sticky traps to learn about emerging pests such as Fall armyworm and Tomato potato psyllid
